## **Polys revamp English lessons for students**

FROM next April, students at [Republic Polytechnic](#) can turn to online material posted by their lecturers to help them improve their proficiency in English.

These modules will be grouped broadly into reading, writing, listening and speaking skills and students can work on each in their own time and at their own pace.

The other four polytechnics - [Nanyang](#), [Ngee Ann](#), [Singapore](#) and [Temasek](#) - are also looking to revamp the English language modules currently available to their students.

They hope to offer more modules as well as organise activities such as dialogues, debates and speech contests for their students.

Their plans follow recommendations earlier this month from the [Ministry of Education's](#) (MOE) English Language Review Committee.

MOE announced that it would be changing the English school curriculum as well as the way in which English teachers are trained. It will also introduce English as a new A-level subject, among other things.
